- ☑ Journaling: every time you read from your book, you are expected to use your literature journal to write down your responses to your book. You may include:
 - questions
 - predictions
 - interesting facts
 - how you think the character is feeling
 - how the book makes you feel
 - anything that helps you make sense of the book

Every time you read, write the date and the page numbers read in your journal. Responses can be in words and pictures.

- ☑ You will have some class time to work on this project, but you will also need to read and work on your project at home to get it done on time.
- ☑ Day 2 of unit: choose book, think about response project
- ☑ Day 4 of unit: no in-class work time, continue reading and journaling at home
- ☑ Day 5 of unit: Whole class period given for work time, use this time to read and journal. You should be almost finished with your book. You will meet with the teacher during this class period to talk about your progress and your plan to complete your project. Teacher initials:_____
