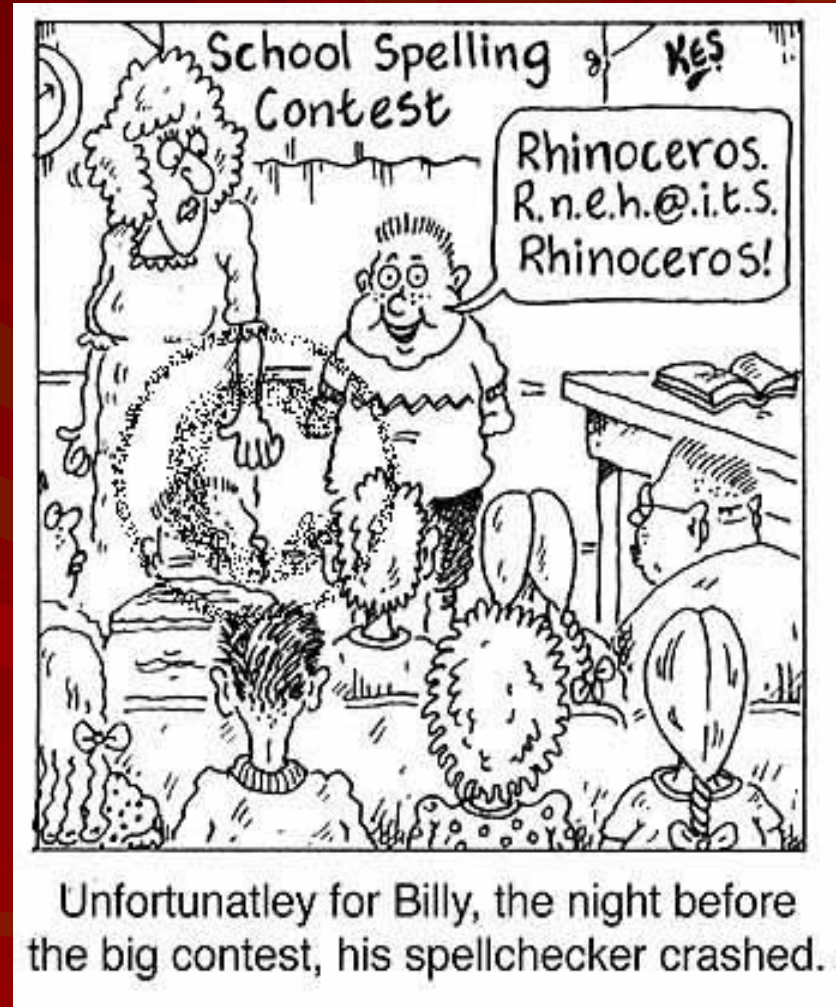
- Completed by ALL candidates.
