Credits & Time Commitments

- Four hours of credit
- Morning and afternoon methods
- Expected to be in school when not in methods class

Conferences

- Weekly appointment with university supervisor
- Daily conference with coop(s)
- Ask for and try to implement suggestions
- Listen and be humble!

Observations

- University supervisor observes twice
- Student Teaching II supervisor observes once
- Video tape of lesson evaluated by you
- Program Director may drop in unannounced
