The Christian Teacher Diploma (CTD) is granted to students who have met all requirements for the teacher education program, have a teaching degree, and are eligible for a teaching license in the State of Nebraska. Students seeking this diploma have indicated an interest in serving as teachers in Christian schools that are not associated with The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod and must apply to the CTD program. All students receiving the CTD are required to take a minimum of six hours of 300 or 400 level theology or philosophy courses.
