The Lutheran Teacher Diploma (LTD) is available to students who are currently members in good standing of a congregation of The Lutheran Church–Missouri Synod. This diploma is granted to students who have met all requirements for the teacher education program, have completed the LTD coursework, are eligible for a teaching license in the State of Nebraska, and have been certified by the faculty as qualified to begin service as called members of the Lutheran teaching ministry. Students wishing to receive the LTD must apply to the program and are required to take a minimum of six hours of 300 or 400 level theology courses on campus. This diploma qualifies the student for minister of religion status in The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod.
