Project Guidelines

Ask yourself, "*what might kids like to learn in a FUN after school activity?*" Pursue the question actively. You will need to plan and conduct an after school activity!



This after school activity will be presented publicly to students at the Seward Youth Center.

Your Finished Product:

1. You need to be able to lead a group of students in this **2-day** activity! Pick a topic you know something about, and enjoy yourself. Make it FUN!! (Take some pictures – you might want them later!)
2. As you lead the activity, take mental notes about the experience – those memories will be important in presenting to your classmates on your experience.
3. When you present to your classmates at the end of the

semester, you will distribute a one-page double-sided professional-looking handout to EVERYONE who will be listening to your presentation. This handout should include:

- ❖ Your activity
- ❖ Reason you chose this topic for your activity
- ❖ Reflections on leading a **2-day** after school activity
- ❖ conclusions/recommendations based on what you learned
- ❖ your name so we know who we can turn to later when we might want to use this activity with others

YOU SHOULD MAKE COPIES to give each of the peers who come to your presentation (for this class, you should make 7 copies!)

Plan your presentation as though you would be sharing this information with other professionals who are working with young adolescents. Practice professionalism! You are encouraged to utilize technology (Power Point or other presentation software) whenever possible.

Be prepared to submit an activity plan – you may use the lesson plan templates found at www.cune.edu/st if you would like.
