Admission Requirements:

- Recommendation by Omaha Public Schools
- 2.50 GPA
- PPST Exam (Pre-Professional Skills Test)
- Application (\$50.00 fee)

Transfer credits:

- Up to 70 credits from a two year institution\*
- Unlimited number of credits from a four year institution\*

Programs:

Bachelors of Science in Education

- Elementary Endorsement
- ELL/ESL Endorsement
- Early Childhood Education Endorsement
- Special Education Concentration (not leading to endorsement)

Masters of Science in Education

- Early Childhood Education
- Educational Administration
- Literacy with Reading Specialist Endorsement
- Literacy with Reading Specialist & ELL/ESL Endorsement
- Secondary Teacher Certification (online only)

Graduation Requirements:

- 2.75 GPA (in education coursework)
- 128 credit hours (30 from Concordia University, Nebraska)
- EECIA Exam (this only applies to early childhood and elementary endorsements)

State Certification:

Concordia University, Nebraska will provide the assistance for state certification requirements.
