

Grade Appeals Received from Educational Administration and Literacy Advisees Since June 2010:

Student S.T. appealed a grade of B- assigned by the professor of her SOC565 class during Spring semester 2011. The review included conversation with the professor about the syllabus, work in the course, and the process of determining the grade. The review committee consisted of Dr. Judy Preuss and Dr. Bob Smallfoot. After consideration of information received from the student the professor determined that the grade should be a B. The review committee affirmed the change.

Student L.W. appealed a grade of F assigned by the professor of his ENG530 class during Spring semester 2011. The review included conversation with the professor about the student's work in the course then conversations with the student's advisor and the Dean. It was determined that the student would be allowed to resubmit the final project for the course and his grade would be changed accordingly. The grade was changed to a D after resubmission.

Student P.J. appealed a grade of A- assigned by the professor of her EDUC594 class during Summer semester 2012. The review involved attempts to contact the instructor who never responded. The Blackboard site supported the student's contention that she had earned the points required for an A in the course. The Dean of the College of Graduate Studies administratively changed the A- to an A.

Action Taken with Student Teachers since 2009

2009-2010	Student A.R. – withdrew between STI and STII
2010-2011	Student A.B. – completed STI and did not complete STII. Returned the following year to complete STII Student A.M. – completed STI and did not complete STII. Graduated with an Educational Studies degree
2011-2012	Student J.C. – was removed from STI Student C.B. – Completed STI and STII. SPED ST was modified and she graduated with an Educational Studies degree.
