

Submit a Video URL to Chalk&Wire

Video files can be big, HUGE things that are difficult to make smaller. Unless they can be made smaller than 200 megabytes, they cannot be uploaded to Chalk&Wire. The solution is to upload them to a video service such as YouTube or Vimeo and then submit a link to Chalk&Wire. As long as the video stays online and is accessible to your instructor for grading, then this is an acceptable solution.

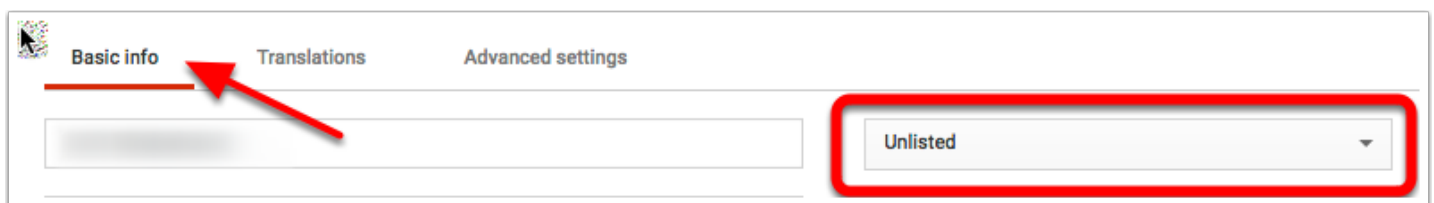

YouTube Settings

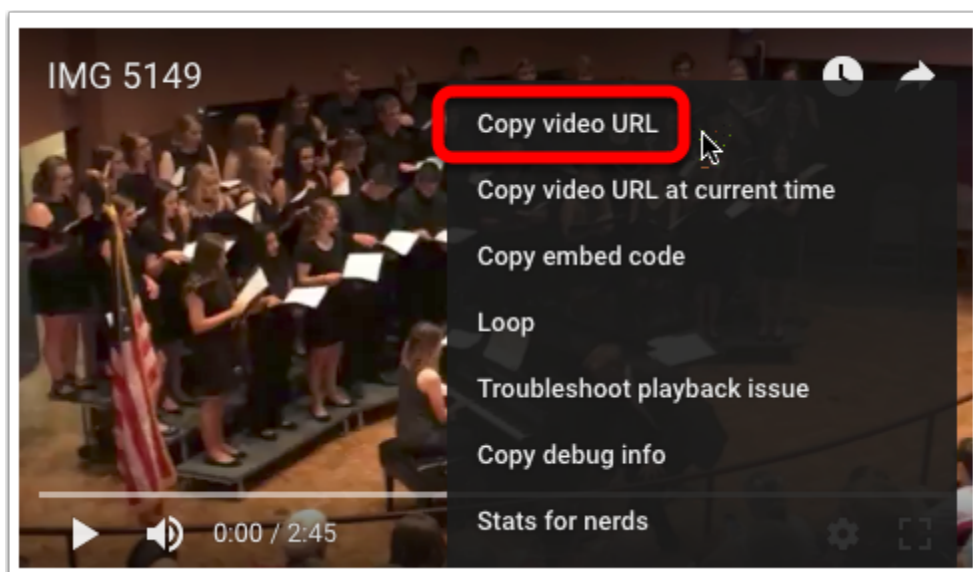
After uploading your video to YouTube, set the video to **Unlisted** in the Basic Info section.

Save your changes.



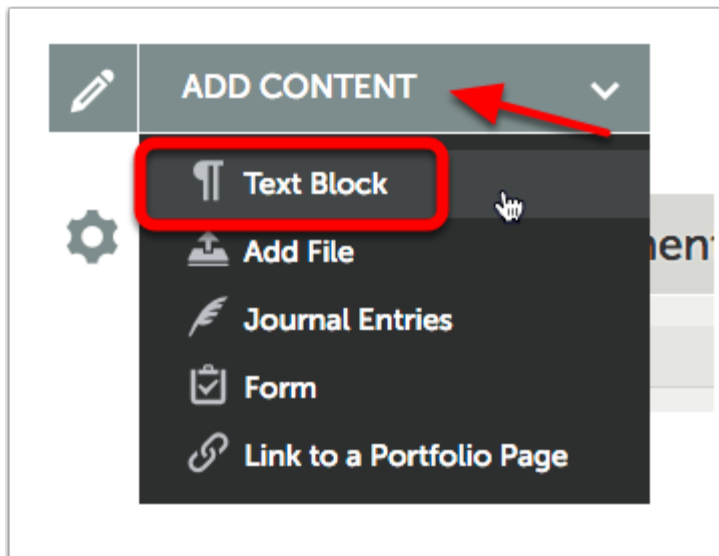
Copy Video URL

Right-click the **video** and *select* **Copy Video URL**



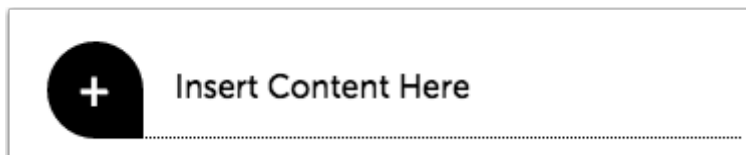

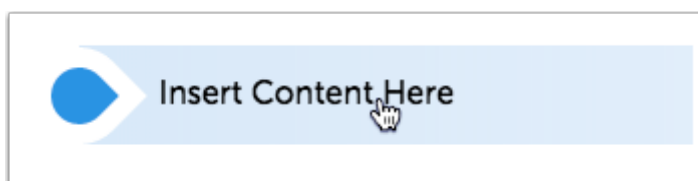




Insert/edit Link Tool

Select the Insert/edit Link tool.

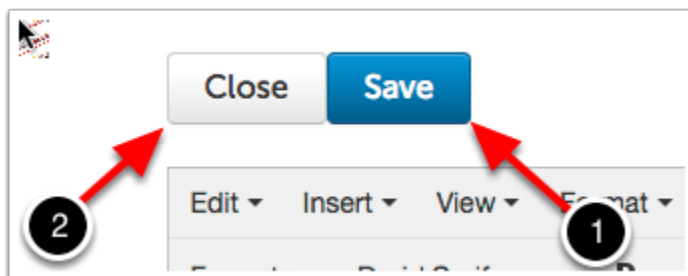


1. *Paste the **YouTube video URL** into the "Url" field.*
2. *Type the **name of the assignment** into the "Text to Display" field.*
3. *Set the "Target" to **New Window**.*
4. *Click **OK**.*
