Final reflection project was submitted on Blackboard and graded.

Do students understand the nine dimensions of holistic health and their manifestation and relevance to a person's overall health and quality of life? Can students adequately and effectively communicate that understanding?

2). Summarize the assessment results. A narrative summary is required. Charts, tables or graphs are encouraged but optional.

Proficiency was defined as 85% of the students communicating through photos and/or written statements relevant positive behaviors and/or goals for at least seven of the nine dimensions of holistic health. Student projects were submitted on Blackboard. [Assignment Instructions attached] One section in both Fall 2022 and Spring 2023 [Dr. Boye's sections] — were given both options (written goals or photo essay) to complete the project. One Section in Spring 2023 [Dr. Harms' section] was required to complete the photo essay. In all three sections, over 85% of the students were able to demonstrate and communicate an understanding of at least seven of the nine dimensions of holistic health. [96% (28 students), 100% - Boye (23 students); 96% (23 students) - Harms]. This was reflected by grade scores of 80% or better. See attached for grade analysis.

3). INTERPRETATION* - Discuss how the results answer the assessment question(s).

A grade of a B or better (80%+) according to the 2022-2023 CUNE Undergraduate Catalog(p14) is categorized as "commendable mastery of the material". Therefore, based on the summary of the assessment results, it is concluded that the student outcome of being able to demonstrate effective communications skills in reflecting on their positive behaviors and/or setting goals for each of the nine dimensions of holistic health has been met.

4). Observations made that were not directly related to the question(s). (i.e. interrater reliability of the scoring tool was low) Although one section was only given the one option to complete the photo essay, it did not appear to impact the assessment results.
