A Selected Bibliography: Distinctions and Conditions of Christian Higher Education

Much has been written over the past twenty-five years on Christian higher education. The titles included here have continued to receive some attention, and reviews are available on most through the usual sources and searches. Several address Lutheran higher education directly or include a chapter on Lutheran colleges and universities.

Many of these books refer to John Henry Newman and his foundational book, *The Idea of a University*, written in 1852 when Newman opened University College, Dublin.

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
